10. Respect other people's opinions, even when they differ from your own. Its rare that two people agree on most topics.

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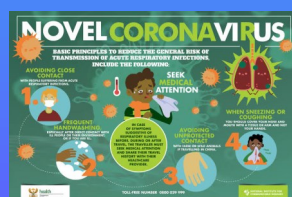

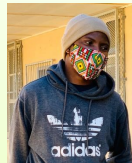
